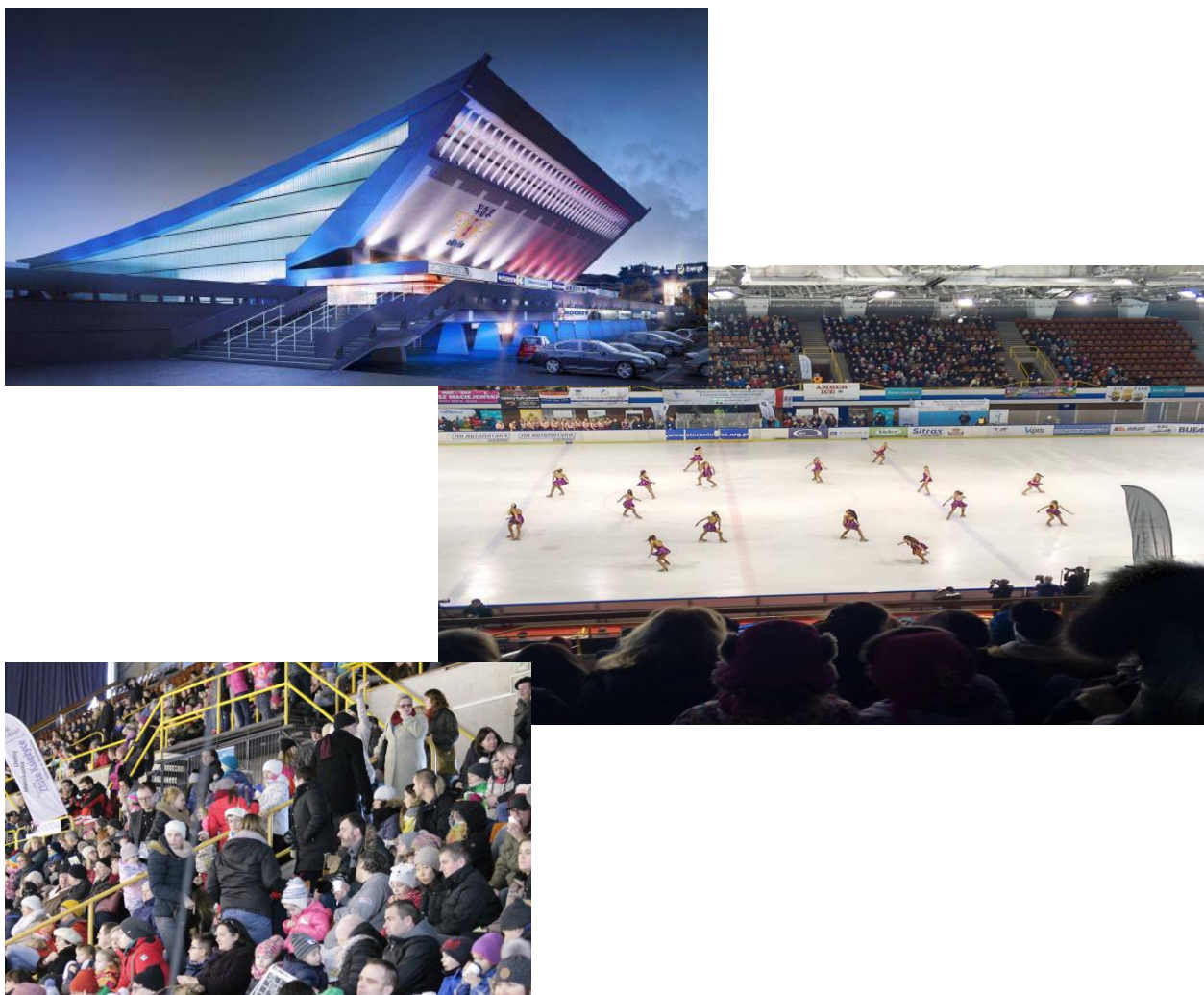
ANNOUNCEMENT / INVITATION

The Polish Figure Skating Association, SKF Iceskater and GKS Stocznowiec have the pleasure to invite the ISU Members to participate in 6th Hevelius Cup 2022. The event will take place on 08-09 January 2022 in Gdansk, Poland.

- Two ice rinks closed and heated - 30 m x 60 m
- Capacity of the arena: 5,500 people
- Warm up area
- The city center - old town only 8 km away from the ice rink
- Parking area for buses
- Airport 12 km away from the ice rink – public transportation to city
- Railway station 500 m away from the ice rink

TECHNICAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

6th Hevelius Cup 2020 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution, ISU General Regulations 2021, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Synchronized Skating, and the relevant ISU Communications.. The teams must belong to an ISU Member (Rule 130, paragraph 7). All skaters must qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102 and participation and citizenship requirements according to Rule 109.

Pre-Juvenile: The free program of the category Pre-Juvenile will be according to the rules of the Basic Novice. Shall consist of 8-16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who have not reached the age of 11 by 1 July 2021 – at least 80% of the team must meet the age category. The rule of 20% / 80% applies to the total number of skaters involved.

Shall consist of 8-16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who have not reached the age of 13 by 1 July 2021 – at least 80% of the team must meet the age category. The rule of 20% / 80% applies to the total number of skaters involved.

Basic Novice: The free program of the category Basic Novice will be according to the rules of the Basic Novice. Shall consist of 12-16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who must have reached at least the age of 10 but have not reached the age of 15 by 1 July 2021

- Free Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 sec), Factor 1.6.
- Elements: Comm. 2238 Basic Novice Free Skating Program. Teams may attempt any level but the highest level that will be called for an element will be one level lower than the highest level.

Advanced Novice: The free program of the category Advanced Novice will be according to the rules of the Advanced Novice. Shall consist of 16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who must have reached at least the age of 10 but have not reached the age of 15 by 1 July 2021

- Free Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 sec), Factor 1.6.
- Elements: Comm. 2238 Advanced Novice Free Skating Program.

Mixed Age: The free program of the category Mixed Age will be according to the rules of the Mixed Age. Shall consist of 8-16 skaters + max 4 alternates. No age limit.

- Free Program: 3 minutes (+/- 10 sec), Factor 1.6.
- Elements: Comm. 2236 Mixed Age Free Skating Program.
- Valuts and Lifts are permitted.

Adult: The free program of the category Adult will be according to the rules of Technical Requirements Season 2020/21 for International Adult Figure Skating & Adult Synchronized Skating Competitions. Shall consist of 8-16 skaters + max 4 alternates, who must have reached at least the age of 18 by 1 July 2021 – at least 80% of the team must meet the age category. The rule of 20% / 80% applies to the total number of skaters involved. Factor 1.6.

All team members will need to identify themselves by a passport or an identity card when registering at the event.

UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE ICE:

Unofficial practice ice is available for all teams on the 7th and 8th January 2022, at Hala Olivia on official or practice ice rink (both rinks are in this same building and have 30 x 60 meter). Costs are € 60 per block of 15 minutes.

TIME SCHEDULE:

The competition will be held on 8-9 January 2022.

The schedule will be published after the preliminary entry on 12 November 2021.

JUDGES, REFEREE AND TECHNICAL PANEL:

The Competition will be judged under the ISU system. Panel of Judges for each competition will consist of:

- 1 Referee,
- 1 Referee's Assistant Ice Level,
- 5-7 Judges,
- 1 Technical Controller,
- 1 Technical Specialists,
- 1 Assistant Technical Specialist,
- 2 Data/Replay operator.

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one (1) Judge, listed on the ISU List of Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating. The Entries of Judges must be made not later than: 3 December 2021.

The Referees, Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers, Data and Replay Operators will be nominated by the Organizing Committee. Travel, accommodation and meals will be paid for Referees, Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialists and the Data/Replay Operators by the Organizing Committee.

DRAW:

The draw will take place at the Hala Olivia.

OPENING CEREMONY :

The opening ceremony will be held on Sunday 9 January 2022.

CLOSING CEREMONY :

The closing ceremony will be held right after the end of the competition day 9 January 2022. Trophies will be awarded to the top three teams of each category.

MUSIC:

All teams shall provide their competition music of excellent quality not later than 3 December 2021 to heveliuscup@iceskater.pl

DOPING:

An anti-doping control may be carried out during the competition in accordance with the valid ISU Anti – Doping Code (ISU Communication No. 2344 or any later update of the Communications.).

PUBLICITY WAIVER:

Each individual and/or team, waive any and all rights to financial remuneration or other compensation for the use or reproduction of their image or likeness, or that of their synchronized skating team and grant permission to use same, as or in publicity prior to, during or following the 6th Hevelius Cup 2022 in Gdansk, Poland.

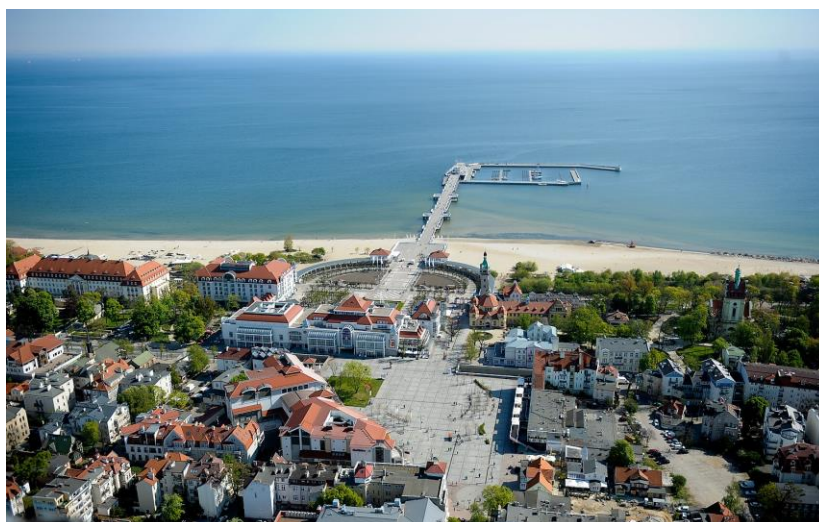
