1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **PGE Halloween Cup 2023** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in **PGE Halloween Cup 2023** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

3. ENTRIES

3.1 General

Each Club can enter unlimited number of skaters in each category.

3.2 Entries by Name

3.2.1 Entries of Competitors

The Entries by names must be made as written above, not later than: Monday, 9th October, 2023 – 24:00 h (local time city of event).

3.2.2 Entries of Judges

Each participating club from abroad has the right to nominate one judge who has at least the qualification "Judge for International Competitions".

The Entries of Judges must be made via e-mail <u>halloweencup@ksiceandroll.pl</u> not later than: Monday, 9th October, 2023 – 24:00 h (local time city of event).

Each panel of Judges will consist of at least 3 Judges.

3.2.3 Entries of Team Members

Official entries **for all** (PZŁF and from abroad) Coaches, Team Leaders, Team Medical Staff will be accepted. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

The names of all team members must be submitted via: Google Form <u>https://forms.gle/uoAy1q24jzdaVpdD8</u> not later than: Monday, 9th October, 2023 – 24:00 h (local time city of event).

3.3 Entry Fee

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

- 280 PLN per single skater
- 330 PLN per couple

170 PLN per second category (if skater competes in more than one category)

Entry fee refund:

- **50%** in case of withdrawals for any reason until the draw
- **No** refund in case of withdrawals for any reason after a draw.

• the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable.

<u>Please note</u>: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

• Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.

• The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.

If the music files have been submitted within the above-mentioned deadline to the Organizing Committee, then the music team of the Organizing Committee is entirely responsible for the correct execution of the music. In case of issues with submitted music files the Organizing Committee may request at the time of registration a secondary copy of the music files. In case the music files have not been submitted in time to the Organizing Committee, the skater(s) must present their music latest at the time of registration on the above defined mean and in the defined format.

<u>Please note</u>: CDs will <u>not</u> be accepted by the Organizing Committee.
