3.1 General

Each Club can enter unlimited number of skaters in each category.

3.2 Entries by Name

3.2.1 Entries of Competitors

The Entries by names must be made as written above, not later than:

Thursday, 19th December, 2024 - 24:00 h (local time city of event).

3.2.2 Entries of Judges

Each participating club from abroad has the right to nominate one judge who has at least the qualification "Judge for National Competitions".

The Entries of Judges must be made via e-mail piotr.nowak91@o2.pl not later than:

Thursday, 19^h December, 2024 – 24:00 h (local time city of event)

Each panel of Judges will consist of at least 3 Judges.

3.2.2 Skaters' entries limitation

Entries for competitors for the Walley Winter Cup are limited according to the table below. - Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.
