The **XXI MiniEuropa 2025** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in **XXI MiniEuropa 2025** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

3. ENTRIES

3.1 General

Entries for the **XXI MiniEuropa 2025** must be done through:

Each Club can enter unlimited number of skaters in each category.

3.2 Entries by Name

3.2.1 Entries of Competitors

The Entries by names must be made as written above, not later than:

Friday, 7th February, 2025 – 24:00 h (local time city of event).

3.2.2 Entries of Judges

Each participating club from abroad has the right to nominate one judge who has at least the qualification “Judge for National Competitions”.

The Entries of Judges must be made via e-mail piotr.nowak91@o2.pl not later than:

Friday, 7th February, 2025 – 24:00 h (local time city of event)

Each panel of Judges will consist of at least 3 Judges.



3.3 Entry Fee

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

300 PLN per single skater
170 PLN per second adult category

Entry fee refund:

- **No** refund in case of withdrawals for any reason after entries are closed.

- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
 - The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.
