The **Diamond Spin 2025** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024, the relevant ISU Communications and rules in technical data below.

In spins in one position with or without change of foot difficult variation must be preceded by 2 revolutions in basic (no variation) position on each foot.

Eg.

- Basic sit position (2 revs), sit forward, sit behind
- Basic sit position (2 revs), sit forward, change of foot, normal sit (2 revs), sit behind

If it is a spin combination, holding basic position before difficult variation of position is not required to be counted.

Spins can be started with jump.

#### Extra Features

- Execution of 6 revolutions in any variation or basic positions (no variation) of sit or camel spins counts as a feature only once in program.
- Three (3) basic positions done on one foot in spin combination with or without change of foot will be counted as a feature only once in the program.

### **III Choreo Step Sequence (ChStSq)**

(max. 1)

There must be a maximum one (1) Choreo Step Sequence fully utilizing ice surface, which must:

- consist of one (1) spiral position (with knee of free foot above the hip level) skated on a curve, kept for minimum 3sec.
- One skating movement (Mondo, Ina Bauer etc.)
- Clearly visible step sequence with attempt of at least two (2) difficult steps or turns

If **first bullet** is missing – No Value will be given

If one of above bullets is missing – „V“ mark will be given.

If two or more of above bullets are missing – No Value will be given.

#### **Level features** (1 feature for lvl 1, 2 features for lvl 2)

- More than 3 sec in difficult spiral position on curve
- Minimum two (2) clean performed steps or turns
- Change of edge in spiral or difficult spiral position, 3 sec in position before and after the change

Examples of difficult spiral positions:

Split position (more than 130 deg.), Biellmann, caught spiral position with free foot above head, spiral position (at least 120 deg.), positions, which requires more physical strength or flexibility

Clearly visible step sequence must contain at least 2 attempts of difficult steps and/or turns connected with different steps. Steps should be done one by one to create one visible pattern. No more than 2 crossovers can be executed in the visible step sequence.

- the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable.

Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.
- During the 1st Official Practice, the music will be played as indicated in the Practice Schedule and will allow to verify the correctness of the submitted music. If there is an issue with the music, the Team Leader/Coach may be allowed to change the music by presenting an acceptable reproduction to the Organizing Committee's Music Team (USB Stick with file format of WAV or MP3 file).

If the music files have been submitted within the above-mentioned deadline to the Organizing Committee, then the music team of the Organizing Committee is entirely responsible for the correct execution of the music. In case of issues with submitted music files the Organizing Committee may request at the time of registration a secondary copy of the music files. In case the music files have not been submitted in time to the Organizing Committee, the skater(s) must present their music latest at the time of registration on the above defined mean and in the defined format.

Please note: CDs will **not** be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

The titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Single, for the Rhythm and Free Dance Program for Ice Dance and for the Exhibition must all be entered, in detail, by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the participants on the dedicated Platform, not later than: **Friday, 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2025 – 24:00 h (local time city of event):**
