The **PGE Halloween Cup 2026** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution 2025, Competition & Event Regulations 2026, Sports Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2026 and the relevant ISU Communications and PFSA Internal Rules for lower categories.

Participation in **PGE Halloween Cup 2026** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

- the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable.

Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.

- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.

If the music files have been submitted within the above-mentioned deadline to the Organizing Committee, then the music team of the Organizing Committee is entirely responsible for the correct execution of the music. In case of issues with submitted music files the Organizing Committee may request at the time of registration a secondary copy of the music files. In case the music files have not been submitted in time to the Organizing Committee, the skater(s) must present their music latest at the time of registration on the above defined mean and in the defined format.

Please note: CDs will **not** be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

The Planned Program Content must also be entered within the registration platform, not later than:

Monday, 28th September, 2026 – 18:00 h (local time city of event):

It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

8. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS

The nearest airports to **Bydgoszcz** are:

- **Bydgoszcz Ignacy Jan Paderewski Airport (BZG)** with a distance of **5 km** to the ice rink.
- **Gdańsk Lech Walesa Airport (GDN)** with a distance **172 km** to the ice rink (Gdańsk has good connection with Bydgoszcz via railway PKP. Gdańsk Wrzeszcz – Bydgoszcz Główna cost aprox. **12EUR** per person / one way
- **Warsaw Chopin Airport (WAW)** with a distance **300 km** to the ice rink (Warsaw has good connection with Bydgoszcz via railway PKP. Warszawa Gdańska – Bydgoszcz Główna cost aprox. **16EUR** per person / one way

If necessary, the Organizing Committee can help with organizing transport from airports.

All nominated by clubs officials are requested to announce to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but no later than **Monday, 5th October, 2026** the airport name, name of the airlines, flight numbers, dates and times of arrival or any other information concerning transportation and arrivals. The detailed travel information need to be sent by email.

9. ACCREDITATION

The official accreditation for Teams is planned at the “**Torbyd Ice Rink**” upon arrival.

Accreditation will only be granted to persons if officially entered and named through their Clubs by PZŁF ORS and Google Forms (for skaters and other participants).

Accreditation will be given to appointed Event Officials and Guests.

10. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.
